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COURSE OVERVIEW

This is a year-long program (January 2026 – December 2026), divided into quarterly areas of focus. Throughout each month individuals are required to watch a pre-recorded lecture, complete a practical application activity related to the month's topic, and engage in two, hour long live group video conferencing sessions to discuss lessons learned, practice skills, and develop action items unique to their circumstance. Dates for live sessions will be determined by cohort participants.

Participants will learn researched based tools to integrate mental wellness with their distinctive leadership skills, fostering an environment that encourages and supports staff at all levels.
